Tips

- Relationships are crucial
- Technology is a tool; Use it when it is the right tool for the experience
- Consider why, when, and how you use technology with young children
- Adult involvement and engagement is important when using technology with children

- Think about technology through the eyes of a child, not an from an adult's perspective
- Be consistent and transparent with your rules around technology use
- Examine your own technology use and how you are modeling technology use in front of your children
