Staff and Faculty Compliance Training

Erikson Institute provides online Title IX training to educate staff and faculty on sexual discrimination and on the prevention of rape, acquaintance rape, domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, and stalking. Completion of this online training is required for all new employees and is also available at all times for easy access.

Erikson uses United Educators “EduRisk Learning Portal”. Instructions to register and access the online training is:
